

Audi Conformity Check Terms & Conditions

- These Audi Conformity Check Terms & Conditions shall apply in case you order the Audi Conformity Check Inspection.
- The Audi Conformity Check Report means the written report produced by us as part of the Audi Conformity Check (“**Report**”).
- Reports are limited to the parts and/or items specifically listed in the Report. Specifically, the check list for the Report is available on request prior to the Audi Conformity Check. Our Report will cover the car’s engine compartment, tyres and wheels, brakes and under body. In addition, your car will be taken on a road test. Audi Conformity Check inspection will include an inspection of the body work, however it will not involve dismantling or disturbing any structure, assembly, component or internal mechanism.
- The Audi Conformity Check will be carried out at the authorized Audi service centres.
- The Audi Conformity Check will be recognised by all authorised Audi dealers within Malaysia.
- We will inspect items listed on the Report except for those items that are not reasonably accessible. In these circumstances we will be under no obligation to inspect and/or report on the part/item in question and will mark the relevant section of the Report accordingly. The car inspection does not guarantee:
(a) that all or any of the components of your car are original components or replacement components, which have been manufactured by the car manufacturer; and/or(b) the authenticity of the registration, the mileage, VIN number, the engine number or the car service history.
- The Audi Conformity Check does not check the general car insurance and service history.
- Road testing is carried out within the immediate area of our service centre where the Audi Conformity Check is to be performed. If, due to circumstances outside of our reasonable control, the car is deemed to be of an un-roadworthy condition, for example, the car's brakes and/or tyres are worn or inadequate, a road test will not be carried out at the time of inspection, the original fee shall remain fully payable and an additional fee may be requested for any subsequent road test we are asked to undertake. Road testing is limited to speed limits in force in the area of testing. Quattro systems and operation are not tested as part of the road test.
- Fees and charges must be paid by major credit card or cash at the time of completion of the Audi Conformity Check. All fees and charges are subject to change without notice. However, we will update our fees and charges regularly in written information we provide and at our website: www.audi.com.my.
- We reserve the right to refuse to conduct a car inspection on any car.
- To the maximum extent permitted by law, we will not be liable to you or any third parties for any claim whether that claim arises in contract, tort (including negligence or statute) for any loss (including loss of profits or special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss), damage, injury or death to any person or property arising out of or relating to the Audi Conformity Check performed by us.

- The inspection is prepared for the person named on the Report and no warranty is offered or provided to any third party other than the person named on the Report, subject to the Audi's 2 year warranty guidelines.
- The Report may indicate a problem but not provide any further information about this problem; this is because further diagnosis or dismantling may be required to provide an accurate diagnosis.
- The inspection Report may, serve as a guide for detailed inspections to be carried out to determine if internal problems exist in the engine, transmission or any other operational component; after general visual checks are carried out on these parts. Your consent will however be first obtained before any detailed inspections is to be carried out, with additional fee applicable.
- The service provider of the Audi Conformity Check will not be held responsible for undetected defects that have been deliberately disguised in order to deceive.
- The service provider of the Audi Conformity Check will not be held responsible for faults or defects that arise after the inspection has been signed off as completed.
- We may change the Audi Conformity Check Terms & Conditions from time to time at our sole discretion and you agree to be bound by these changes after the date of the change. The latest Audi Conformity Check Terms & Conditions will be updated on the brand portal www.audi.com.my.
- We cannot and will not guarantee that any identified aftermarket modifications found during the car inspection to have been carried out safely or in accordance with Audi guidelines or specifications. Therefore the authorized service centre will not be held accountable for the aftermarket parts fitted or modifications that have been carried out to the car.
- Should any warranty claim arise on the car, the Audi 2 year warranty guidelines will apply, please visit our brand portal www.audi.com.my or visit any Audi's authorised dealers for more information.
- If any particular provision of this Audi Conformity Check Terms & Conditions shall be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void or unenforceable, the other provisions shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.
