**FC BAYERN MÜNCHEN AG (referred to hereinafter as FCB)
General Terms and Conditions for the Purchase of Tickets
(referred to hereinafter as Tickets GTC)**

1. Scope of Application

The purchase and use of admission tickets (tickets) are covered solely and exclusively by the present Tickets GTC which you duly accept through the purchase or use of tickets. This does not apply to tickets ordered through the internet, which are subject to the Ticketing GTC specified for such orders. Access and admission to the Stadium is furthermore subject to the Stadium Rules and Regulations on display at the event.

2. Terms and Conditions of Payment, Orders and Mailing

2.1. Orders are taken and accepted only against payment in advance. The amount shown in the invoice shall be settled within the period specified for payment.

Should this not be the case or should coverage on a credit card or bank/financial account not be sufficient, FCB is entitled to cancel the order without replacement and/or to electronically invalidate the tickets involved. FCB also reserves the right to claim damages under such circumstances.

2.2 Members and registered fan clubs of FCB may be given preference in the receipt of tickets. Each member is entitled to purchase only one ticket at the reduced price for members. Holders of annual tickets do not receive any reduction for members on day tickets. There shall be no reduction of ticket prices in the case of matches for the DFB (German Football Association) Cup. Children under 14, severely disabled persons and old-age pensioners over 65 receive a discount of 50 per cent on all seats.

2.3 Unless the purchaser states otherwise, FCB is entitled, should the category of tickets ordered be sold out, to give the purchaser an alternative category and/or to limit the number of tickets provided without previous notice, instead of turning down and rejecting the offer.

2.4 Tickets shall be mailed at the cost and risk of the purchaser, with the exception of cases of gross negligence or wanton action on the part of FCB or persons acting on FCB's behalf. The company assigned with the postage and shipping of tickets shall be chosen and appointed by FCB. The purchaser undertakes to check tickets after receipt to ensure they are correct

3. Returning Tickets/Loss of Tickets

Tickets may be returned only if a match is postponed or cancelled. In such a case the purchaser is required to send back the tickets immediately. Reimbursement shall be made only against submission of the original tickets. There shall be no reimbursement or replacement of lost tickets.

4. Use and Sale of Tickets, Contractual Penalty

4.1 For reasons of security, to ensure a broad supply of tickets, and to prevent illicit trading of tickets, purchasers are entitled to buy FCB tickets for private use only. You are therefore required to purchase and use tickets only for private purposes and undertake to follow this rule. The purchase of tickets for commercial or trade-based re-sale (i.e. with a profit), without the prior consent of FCB, is not allowed. The commercial or trade-based re-sale (assignment) of tickets and/or any and all claims and rights derived therefrom is likewise not allowed.

4.2 Should FCB determine that you have purchased tickets for commercial or trade-related purposes without due consent and permission or have sold tickets on a commercial basis and/or have assigned claims arising therefrom for commercial or trade-related purposes (in particular via ebay or ticket agencies), FCB shall be entitled to refuse any further sale of tickets to you, to ban you from the premises, and, for every infringement of the rules and requirements set forth under item 4.1 above, to demand payment of an appropriate contractual penalty of up to Euro 2,500.-. FCB reserves the right in such a case to report the circumstances involved in an appropriate manner also with your name in order to prevent illicit use and trading of tickets in future. FCB also reserves the right to assert further claims and demands under civil and penal law.

5. Access to the Stadium, Rights in One's Own Image

5.1 Persons entering the Stadium and its surrounding areas do so at their own risk. Entry to the Stadium is furthermore subject to the Stadium Rules and Regulations on display at the Stadium.

5.2 Each ticket holder irrevocably agrees to the free use of his image and voice, without any financial claims, by all current and future media, for the purpose of photographs, live broadcasts, programmes and/or recordings of pictures and/or sound produced and made by FCB or others acting on its behalf in the context of the event.

5.3 Access to the Stadium is subject to the Stadium Rules and Regulations on display at the venue of the event. In the interest of safety, security and a smooth course of the event, the ticket holder undertakes in particular to duly follow and obey instructions by the police, FCB, security personnel and the stadium management in the Stadium. Visitors are allowed to take banners, etc into the Stadium only with the permission and due consent of FCB. They are not allowed to take in cameras and any other image/film and audio recording devices for the purpose of commercial use. Taking fireworks, bottles, cans, drugs and alcoholic beverages as well as pets/animals into the Stadium is strictly forbidden. Spectators visibly under the influence of alcohol lose their right to enter the Stadium. Children have access to the Stadium only with a valid ticket, and may claim access on a reduced-rate ticket only upon submission of due evidence confirming the reason and justification for the reduced price. Spectators in any way violating the Tickets GTC and/or the Stadium Rules and Regulations shall be expelled from the Stadium without reimbursement of the price paid for their ticket.

6. Data Privacy

FCB seeks in every way to duly maintain and observe the data privacy regulations currently in force. FCB shall therefore use data provided only in the context of legal rules and regulations, for example to fulfil the contract or to inform you on goods or services similar to the goods or services you have ordered. You are entitled at any time to reject the use or transfer of your data for advertising purposes or for use in market or opinion research. We undertake to inform you of this right of refusal with every advertising announcement made.

7. Place of Venue and Jurisdiction

Should the other party hereto be a merchant or businessperson within the meaning of the German Commercial Code, a legal entity under public law or a representative of public/legal assets, should he not have a general place of venue and jurisdiction in Germany or if his place of residence or usual place of abode is not known at the time of filing legal action, the only place of venue and jurisdiction for any and all disputes arising out of or in the context of this contractual relationship, as well as the place of venue for payment, delivery and the provision of services, shall be the home address of FCB in Munich.

8. Applicable Law, Additional Agreements, Contact

8.1 The present Contract is subject to German law and excludes UN merchant law. There are no further verbal agreements between the parties hereto. Any and all amendments of these General Terms and Conditions shall be made in writing. Transmission of such amendments by telefax or e-mail shall not meet this requirement of submitting amendments in written form. Should individual items of this Tickets GTC be invalid in full or in part, or should they be or become impossible to fulfil, this shall not affect the validity of the present Contract and the other terms and provision contained herein.
